

The GoFundMe Tip

Rather than charging a platform fee on personal campaigns, GoFundMe gives donors the option to add a voluntary tip. Your donation receipt will show you a breakdown of your donation and tip amount. On your statement, this will either show up as a single total charge or as two separate charges.

How to change the default amount (15% of donation)

- 1) Click on the arrow beside the tip amount
